- 4 The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entries without stating a reason or disqualify an entrant who displays bad behaviour.
- 5 The Organisers reserve the right to alter or amend the details in this schedule according to the circumstances.
- 6 In this clause, the term Exhibitor shall include persons taking part in any competition or display arranged by the Organisers, and the owner of any animal, plant, machinery or other thing involved in any such competition or display or otherwise exhibited on the Showground.

7 Protective headgear manufactured to BSI or European Standard must be worn at all times while riding on the Showground, with the chinstrap correctly and securely fastened.
